TO DO at Haig Park

1. Go on a colour walk! Take a walk around the park, collecting as many different colours as you can, or pick a colour and see how many things you can find in that shade!
2. Play hide and seek with your friends and family. How long can you hide before someone spots you?
3. See how many bugs, critters and birds you can find in one expedition. Where are they hiding? Do they prefer sun or shade?
4. Have a picnic amongst the trees. There are over 2,500 trees planted in Haig Park, how many can you count?
5. Make a simple insect hotel or magnificent minibeast mansion with sticks and leaves amongst the trees.
6. Go on a photo safari in the park. Choose a subject (or colour scheme) and see what you can capture.
7. Make a stick boat or send fallen leaves down the creek - race your friends to the end.
8. Hold up a wet finger and feel which way the wind is blowing. Release a feather or leaf and investigate where it ends up on a windy day. Can you work out the direction of the wind?
9. Create a natural obstacle course or race track and time each other as you go through it.
10. Participate in a Haig Park community event activity with your family and friends.
